Crucial Numbers

- Directory that has numbers
- Phone book that has all numbers of resident
- Weekend manager (manager is on every weekend)
- Activity director
- Medical button that sends an alert to healthcare on campus, often they call right away
- Personal nurse that works for independent or assisted living (number for that)
- Maintenance person
- Don't change often, nurse changes every now and then
- Button alerts to where person is, local to around 25 feet of central location

Public Internet Point

- Useful to have in case someone does not have device with them or don't have them at all
- Some sort of browser of library like public internet thing

Major Features

- Paper for every single schedule/activity change
- Rules/regulations

Annoyances/Things to not See

- No downloads off campus, avoid spam/scam callers
